Monday 28th December

Meeting at the **Fox and Hounds** pub in **Christmas Common, OX49 5HL, 10.15 a.m.** for a **10.30 start**.

The walk will take us through peaceful woodland and a field or two. There will be a couple of options to shorten the walk or to alter it if it is too slippery on the day. Maps will be provided to get you all back to the pub whichever route you choose. The longest route is still quite short, taking about 1 hour 30 minutes at a leisurely pace.

Of course, you may not wish to walk and have lunch so you are welcome to come to just one. For those who just want a lunch then we will be sitting down at table by about 12.15.

If you intend to come then could you please let me know your name(s) and the **number** of people in your party, how many are **just walking**, how many **just having lunch** and how many for **both**.

The **lunch menu** and map are attached. Please study the menu and give me an indication of what you would like to order so that I can let the pub know in advance, which would be helpful to them, especially over the Christmas period.

After lunch I would suggest spending a few minutes on **Watlington Hill** for the fantastic view over the vale of Oxford. There is a car park just round the corner from the pub and it only takes a few minutes to walk out onto the hill from there. It is well worth a visit before heading off home.

I need to let the pub know numbers and meal choices by **Monday 21st December**. I can appreciate that this might not be easy if you have friends and relatives attached but could you please give it a try and let me know before then.
